GET INVOLVED—Get Connected is a free, web-based service offered by United Way of Laurens County that helps connect local non-profit organizations and volunteers. It's a simple tool that allows agencies to inform the community of upcoming events/needs, while volunteers stay informed and able to help out in various ways.

PROMOTE LITERACY—The Imagination Library is a Dollywood Foundation program offered by United Way of Laurens County and School District 55. In an effort to promote early childhood literacy and family reading, this program allows new, age-appropriate books to be mailed once a month to Laurens County children ages 5 and under. Currently, more than 1,200 children are enrolled and receiving monthly books.

Born Learning is designed as a tool for long-lasting community change that supports young children. It has three cornerstones: awareness about how young children learn; easy, fun, educational action steps that parents, grandparents and caregivers can use every day; and availability of research-driven products and tools for education outreach.

HELP SOMEONE SAVE MONEY—Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) is a free service offered by United Way of Laurens County to help low-income families file their state and federal taxes—free of charge. Any household making under \$53,000 during the 2015 year will qualify for this service in 2016. We are looking for volunteers to help those in need of this service. GROW RESOURCES FOR OUR COMMUNITY—2-1-1 is a one-stop resource for finding assistance in Laurens County. New to our Community, a database is kept of local resources & service providers including support groups, community clinics, counselors, shelters, food pantries, programs for seniors, and many more agencies in South Carolina.

SUPPORT SENIOR ADULTS—Bags of Love is a neighborhood-focused event to let our elderly and shut-ins know that we, as a community, are thinking of them! United Way and Senior Options collect small gift bags filled with candy, books, pens, lotions, etc. that are handed out during the week of Valentine's Day to our Meals On Wheels recipients. This event is an inexpensive way to tell others you care! Get your family and/or your workplace involved by asking others to collect goodie bags for this event!





GIVE 3 HOURS OF TIME—Day of Caring is an annual United Way event that deploys teams of volunteers on-site to local service organizations around the community to perform hands-on tasks. Projects are simple enough that volunteers can accomplish the task in a three-hour time period. Examples include simple landscaping, painting, spring cleaning, or organizational projects. This is a great opportunity to give back to those agencies that help so many in times of need.

PLAY FOR PROGRAMS—United Way hosts an annual **Community Golf Championship**. Proceeds of this tournament directly fund the many great programs powered by the UWLC. Businesses and individuals come together to form 4-man teams in a captain's choice format. Join us for a great afternoon of golf, food, and beverage all while supporting many programs. DONATE SCHOOL SUPPLIES—Our annual **School Supplies Drive** helps us make sure that we are getting kids off to a great start each year.
